

Opportunity: High School Volunteer

Description: Engage with and encourage our High School Students

Time: Sunday Mornings 10:30-11:30 or Wednesday Nights 7:00-8:30

Commitment: 4 services per month

Reports to: Youth Director and Youth Coordinator

Sunday:

- Please arrive at 10:00 for pancakes in the KAY café and then be ready to attend contemporary service at 10:30 with our students (sitting with them in the student section).

Wednesday:

- Please arrive at 6:30 for connection time with students in the café.
- Please sit with, worship with, and engage with students.

What to Expect:

- Be ready to participate in setup, games, and other Youth activities.
- Engage primarily with students! (instead of spending the majority of time interacting with other volunteers)
- Look for people that could take your place and/or join our team. In other words, always look for someone else to serve with you. Ask others' to "test drive" your role and serve alongside you for a Sunday Morning or Wednesday Night. Help us grow our volunteer base!
- Please bring an overwhelmingly upbeat and positive attitude to the program. Students will match the attitude and energy set by the adults in the room. Enthusiasm and a smile goes a long way! If we are excited to be there, they will be too.

Volunteers can assist in a number of ways within the youth ministry. If you are interested in something specific, please let us know!

- **Worship/Tech/Sound:** If you have a heart or passion for leading worship or playing an instrument, we would love for you to assist in leading our worship services. You would have to be available for worship practice and stage cleaning. This role could often include you collaborating with students to facilitate worship and would be a great connection opportunity.
- **Information Gatherer:** We see a lot of students throughout the year, and it is our goal to maintain great communication. Capturing information on who is attending for the first time, who hasn't been in a while, and who has returned is vital to this ministry. If you are talented or passionate about making sure the flock is taken care of let us know!

- **Leading / Creating Games:** Did you love being goofy or silly in school? Have you found yourself creating different ways to play kick ball? We would love help and assistance in leading, creating, and managing our games and fun activities. Providing engaging activities helps us create a fun environment that students want to be in.
- **Encourager:** Are you the type of person that really values when someone notices you? Do you have a way with words, or do you recognize the importance of a thank you note? We would love it if you would partner with us to encourage students. We would love to be able to send thank you notes and information to first time attenders, miss you notes to people we haven't seen in a while, and encouraging notes and prayers to our regular attenders.
- **Mentors:** Are you someone who is passionate about discipleship? Or would you be interested in leading a small group? We have life groups for our students and welcome leaders to come along side and help lead and be present and praying for our students.

Requirements:

- Christ Follower, which can be seen in their life.
- Willingness to positively engage with people you previously have not met
- Regularly attends a worship service at FOPC
