



### Key Passage

**Proverbs 3:5-6** | Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight.



### Big Picture Question

**What does it mean to sin?**

To sin is to think, speak, or behave in any way that goes against God and His commands.



### Bible Story

**Moses' Farewell (Deuteronomy 31-34)**

- Moses had led God's people for more than 40 years, but he could not enter the promised land.
- Moses told the people goodbye and gave a special message.
- Moses reminded the people to keep God's covenant.
- God selected Joshua to lead the people after Moses.



### Family Discussion Starters

1. How does knowing God is with us change how we act and think?
2. Why did Moses tell the priests to read the law to the people every seven years? Why is it important for us to read God's Word?
3. Why didn't Moses get to enter the promised land? (See Numbers 20:7-12)
4. What two things did God tell Joshua to be?
5. Where does our strength and courage come from?



### Family Activity

- Read the Ten Commandments from Exodus 20 or Deuteronomy 5 together as a family.
- Set aside time a few nights this week to pray with your family. Focus specifically on praying for the leaders of your community, church, and country.
