### Big Picture Question

**Is anything or anyone greater than God?**

No, God is greater than everything and everyone.



### Bible Story

**The Ark Was Captured (1 Samuel 4-6)**

- Israel decided to take the Ark of God into the battle.
- Israel lost, and the Philistines took the Ark.
- The Philistines began to get sick in the cities where the Ark was kept.
- God showed the Philistines that He is the one true God.



### Family Discussion Starters:

1. Why did the Israelites take the Ark of God into battle?
2. How did the Ark of God remind His people that He was with them?
3. Do you always consult God when something doesn't work out the way you think it should? Why or why not?
4. What things in our lives might we value more than God?



### Family Activity

- Search online and identify a people group that does not worship God. Find their location on a map. Pray for people to take the gospel to this people group so they may be saved.
- Walk through your neighborhood with your family. Take a paperclip and ask if your neighbors will trade it for something a little greater or more valuable. Continue trading up in this way. Remind your family that nothing and no one is greater than God.
